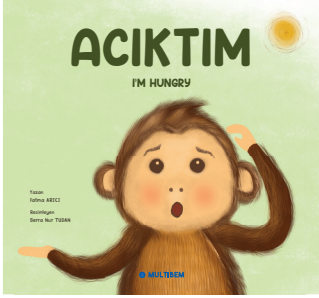

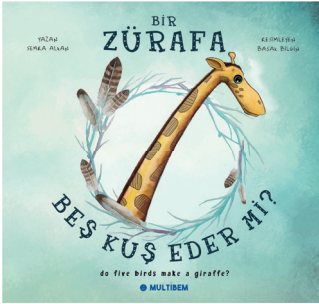


I'm Hungry *Acıktım*

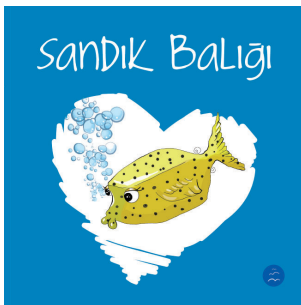
